# Understanding and Mastering ADHD

Despite its name of "Attention Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder", difficulties with attention and hyperactivity are merely the "tip of the iceberg" in most youngsters with ADHD and do not come close to describing the underlying difficulties which really characterize this condition. As such, merely addressing and treating problems with attention and hyperactivity is likely to be inadequate in helping children with ADHD to function happily and successfully - whether academically, emotionally, behaviorally, or socially. This talk will help participants to more thoroughly understand the true nature of ADHD, including what the core problems really are and how to best identify and deal with them (both pro-actively, as well as re-actively) in all aspects of our children's day-to-day lives.

Presenter: Robert F. Chase, Ph.D. is a Clinical Psychologist with more than twenty years of experience specializing in neuropsychological, psycho-educational, and emotional assessment of children, adolescents, and adults with academic, vocational, and/or emotional/behavioral challenges. He regularly advises parents on obtaining the school support needed by their children and has also participated extensively in school conferences, presenting diagnostic test results and their implications for educational interventions.
