Background:

As stated on the official Buddy Walk website: **"The Buddy Walk**[®] was established in 1995 by the National Down Syndrome Society to celebrate Down Syndrome Awareness Month in October and to promote acceptance and inclusion of people with Down syndrome. Today, the Buddy Walk program is supported nationally by NDSS and organized at the local level by parent support groups, schools and other organizations and individuals".

"The Buddy Walk is now in its twentieth year. What started in 1995 as 17 walks has grown to more than 250 walks across the country and around the world. Last year alone, 295,000 people participated in a buddy walk and collectively they raised over \$11.75 million to benefit local programs and services, and NDSS national advocacy initiatives".

What is the Buddy Walk?

The Buddy Walk is a one-mile walk in which anyone can participate without special training. It is an inspirational and educational event that celebrates the many abilities and accomplishments of people with Down syndrome. Whether you have Down syndrome, know someone who does, or just want to show your support, come and join our Buddy Walk!





The 14th Annual Buddy Walk will be a full day event in Baker Park featuring music, entertainment, games, a petting zoo, face painting, a large variety of food, local community resources, and vendors who support F.R.I.E.N.D.S.
